## 2023 CONSENT FORM

At **Deans Marsh Primary School** we aim to offer your child the widest range of learning opportunities and celebrate learning whenever possible. This may often require some form of parental consent. This form asks you to consent (or otherwise) to your child's participation / use / access to several aspects of the school program. At all times we make the very best efforts to exercise exemplary standards in respect of duty of care.

### MEDIA CONSENT

Children's images, and/or their work are often published to celebrate student achievements and may appear in newsletters, on Compass, on our school website, on the internet, in local newspapers or school promotional material. Their names may also be included but no contact details are provided.

- Yes, I give consent to my child to have his/her image and/or work published as described above.
- No, I do not give consent.

### INTERNET ACCESS

Student access to the internet is provided in accordance with the ICT Acceptable Use Policy (available from the school website). Student access is contingent on abiding by the users' Code of Conduct.

- Yes, my child has permission to access the internet in accordance with school policy. I have discussed the scenarios, potential problems and responsible use of the internet with them as outlined in the Acceptable Use Policy.
- No, I do not give consent.

### VIEWING CONSENT

Children occasionally watch television documentaries/videos/dvd's as part of their learning. Almost always these are 'G' rated and don't require consent. Very occasionally something with a 'PG' rating is appropriate for which we would need parental permission.

- Yes, I consent to my child viewing items with a 'PG' rating if deemed suitable by the teacher and school administration.
- No, I do not give consent.

### LOCAL EXCURSIONS

From time to time teachers within the school find it advantageous to take the students on local excursions. A local excursion is one in the local area that the students either walk to or "bus" a short distance eg. Bambra Plantation and have few or any costs attached. This may be a nature walk to the "Marotta Wetlands", a walk to the shop or a run around "Frogwood Arboretum".

- Yes, I consent to my child participating in teacher supervised local excursions. I also authorise the teacher in charge of the excursion/activity to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me, to the child receiving such medical or surgical treatment as may be deemed necessary.
